# SPECIES SELECTED FOLLOWING COP15

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. Following the 15th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP15, Doha, 2010), 24 animal taxa were selected for the Review of Significant Trade at the 25th meeting of the Animals Committee (AC25, Geneva, July 2011) on the basis information provided in documents AC25 Doc. 9.3 and AC25 Doc. 9.6.
- 3. The Secretariat notified the range States on 30 August 2011 of the selected taxa, explained the reason for this selection and requested comments regarding possible problems with the implementation of Article IV of the Convention. Range States were given 60 days to respond (i.e. until 29 October 2011). As requested by the Animals Committee, the Secretariat emphasized that a decision to include a species in the Review of Significant Trade was not, at the outset, intended as a punitive measure for the Party concerned and that, if the Animals Committee were satisfied with the response, the review would conclude. It also indicated that responses did not need to be exhaustive in this first stage of the review.
- 4. The selected taxa, the range States concerned and the responses received at the time of writing the present document (mid-January 2012) are shown in the table below.
- 5. Copies of the responses from affected range States will be forwarded to the members of the Animals Committee in the language in which they were received 45 days before the present meeting.

# Actions required by the Animals Committee

- 6. In accordance with paragraph f) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13), the Committee is invited to review the available information and, if satisfied that Article IV, paragraph 2 (a), 3 or 6 (a), is correctly implemented, to eliminate the species mentioned above from the review with respect to the range States concerned.
- 7. In the event that the species is not eliminated from the review, in accordance with paragraph g) of the same Resolution, the Secretariat will proceed with the compilation of information regarding the species for later consideration by the Committee.
