This document has been prepared by the Scientific Authority for plants of the United Kingdom, Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew.

Status of new plant checklists since the 9th meeting of the CITES Plants Committee, Darwin (Australia), 7 - 11 June 1999:

1. **The Bulb Checklist** (1999, compiled by the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, United Kingdom) and its updates approved by the Nomenclature Committee, as a guideline when making reference to the names of species of Cyclamen (Primulaceae) and Galanthus and Sternbergia (Liliaceae);

Status: Published, 1999. Produced with financial support of The Netherlands Ministry for Agriculture, Nature Management and Fisheries.

2. The CITES Orchid Checklists, (compiled by the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, United Kingdom) and the updates accepted by the Nomenclature Committee, as a guideline when making reference to the names of species of:

Cattleya, Cypripedium, Laelia, Paphiopedilum, Phalaenopsis, Phragmipedium, Pleione and *Sophronitis* (Volume 1);

Cymbidium, Dendrobium, Disa, Dracula and Encyclia (Volume 2);

Aerangis, Angraecum, Ascocentrum, Bletilla, Brassavola, Calanthe, Catasetum, Miltonia and Miltoniopsis, Renanthera, Rhynchostylis, Rossioglossum, Vanda and Vandopsis (Volume 3);

and Aerides, Coelogyne, Comparettia, Lycaste, Masdevallia and Oncidium (Volume 4);

Status: Volume 1 published, 1995. Volume 2 published, 1997. Volume 3 final draft - publication before 28 February 2001. Volume 4 in preparation - orchid experts urgently required to review drafts for each genus.

3. **Standard reference for Aloe and Pachypodium** (Apocynaceae) (compiled by Städische Sukkulenten-Sammlung, Zurich, Switzerland in collaboration with the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, UK).

Status: Final draft - publication before 28 February 2001.

4. **Standard reference for Carnivorous plants** (compiled by members of the IUCN/SSC Carnivorous Plant Specialist Group).

Status: Draft checklist submitted.
