Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species

SPECIES SELECTED FOLLOWING COP15

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. At its 19th meeting (PC19, Geneva, April 2011) and pursuant to paragraph a) under 'Selection of species to be reviewed' of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13), the Plants Committee selected 5 species for review, on the basis of trade data from the CITES database of annual report statistics and the information available to the Committee. In compliance with paragraph d) of the same section of the Resolution, within 30 days after PC19 the Secretariat consulted the range States concerned on their implementation of Article IV, paragraphs 2 (a) and 3, with regard to trade in the selected species.
- 3. In compliance with paragraph e) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13), the Secretariat presents in the Annex a status of the responses that were received from range States for each species. Copies of all responses will be made available to the Plants Committee working group on the Review of Significant Trade as necessary.
- 4. In accordance with paragraph f) of the same section of the same Resolution, the Plants Committee is invited to review the available information to determine whether it is satisfied that Article IV, paragraphs 2 (a) and 3, are being implemented. If so, the species shall be eliminated from the review with respect to the range State concerned and the Secretariat shall notify the Parties accordingly within 60 days. In the event that the species is not eliminated, the Secretariat shall proceed with the compilation of information and preliminary categorization regarding the species in accordance with paragraphs g) to j) of the Resolution.
