CROSS-BORDER MOVEMENT OF LIVE ANIMALS

1. At its 10th meeting the Conference of the Parties decided (Decision 10.142) that:

Recommendations shall be prepared on the basis of proposals submitted by interested Parties, for consideration by the Standing Committee in 1998, in order to establish:

- a) a single simplified procedure for transborder movements of live animals for exhibition travelling to other States;
- b) an effective and rational system of registration and identification of live animals for exhibition; and
- c) principles and methods for certification of travelling owners supposed to travel to other States under the simplified procedure for transborder movements of live animals for exhibition.
- 2. The Secretariat has received no proposal from interested Parties and, consequently, this Decision has not been implemented.
