GUIDELINES FOR THE PREPARATION OF ANNUAL REPORTS

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. Decision 11.154 of the Conference of the Parties states that the Secretariat shall amend Notification to the Parties No. 1999/85 on Annual Reports to clarify, *inter alia*, certain reporting terminology in relation to coral.
- 3. In addition, the Secretariat seeks the Standing Committee's approval to make certain amendments recommended by the Animals Committee, in the context of its work under Resolution Conf. 8.9 (Rev.). These proposed amendments, marked in bold in the Annex, relate to section 5 (Terminology) of the Guidelines for the preparation and submission of CITES annual reports transmitted with Notification to the Parties No. 1999/85.

RECOMMENDATION

4. The Secretariat recommends that the Standing Committee approve the amendments to the Guidelines for the preparation and submission of annual reports, as shown in the Annex.
