FORGIVENESS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE TRUST FUND

This document has been prepared and is submitted by the Secretariat.

- 1. As of 31 August 1989, the unpaid contributions to the Trust Fund for 1988 and prior years amount to US\$ 877,714. It should be noted that three Parties, Argentina (US\$ 39,743), the German Democratic Republic (US\$ 94,087) and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (US\$ 727,150) account for more than 98% of the total unpaid contributions leaving only US\$ 16,734 of unpaid contributions for the remaining Parties (see Annex 1).
- 2. Several Parties, mainly those with smaller contributions, have established a pattern of paying up to three years at a time which means that much of the remaining US\$ 16,734 could be received at any time. With respect to the three above-mentioned Parties, the German Democratic Republic and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics have never made any contributions. However, Argentina last made a partial contribution in 1982.
- 3. Of the total amount outstanding, ten Parties still have unpaid contributions for 1986 and prior years. The list of those Parties and the unpaid contributions for 1986 and prior years can be found in Annex 2. The majority of unpaid contributions (99.5%) rests with Argentina, the German Democratic Republic and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
- 4. The Secretariat recommends to the Conference of the Parties that the unpaid contributions for 1986 and prior years be forgiven in the hope that this gesture by the Parties could have a positive effect in convincing all Parties to contribute their full assessed contributions to the Trust Fund and to do it in a timely manner.
- 5. If this recommendation is approved, a total of US\$ 302,951 would remain as unpaid contributions as of 31.12.88.
