DRAFT DECISIONS OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES

**Directed to the Secretariat**

The Secretariat shall:

- 13.xx a) distribute the Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines for the Sustainable Use of Biodiversity to all CITES Management and Scientific Authorities;
- b) invite the Parties to provide the Animals and Plants Committees with case studies on how these Principles and Guidelines could be used in specific cases of exports of CITES Appendix-II species;
- c) incorporate consideration of these Principles and Guidelines into its work plan, with reference to CITES non-detriment findings and capacity building, in particular for CITES Scientific Authorities;
- d) **following completion of the work of the Animals and Plants Committee, in cooperation with the chairs of Animals and Plants Committee**, incorporate relevant Principles and Guidelines as identified by the Animals or Plants Committees into its capacity-building programme for CITES Scientific Authorities; and
- e) **prepare a report on how the Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines could be incorporated in its work, subject to availability of external funding.**
