The Secretariat shall:

- 13.xx a) distribute the Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines for the Sustainable Use of Biodiversity to all CITES Management and Scientific Authorities;
 - b) invite the Parties to provide the Animals and Plants Committees with case studies on how these Principles and Guidelines could be used in specific cases of exports of CITES Appendix-II species;
 - c) incorporate consideration of these Principles and Guidelines into its work plan, with reference to CITES non-detriment findings and capacity building, in particular for CITES Scientific Authorities;
 - d) following completion of the work of the Animals and Plants Committee, in cooperation with the chairs of Animals and Plants Committee, incorporate relevant Principles and Guidelines as identified by the Animals or Plants Committees into its capacity-building programme for CITES Scientific Authorities; and
 - e) prepare a report on how the Addis Ababa Principles and Guidelines could be incorporated in its work, subject to availability of external funding.
