**Draft revision of Resolution Conf. 11.11 (Rev. CoP14)**

**Regulation of trade in plants**

***Regarding the definition of 'artificially propagated'***

ADOPTS the following definitions for terms used in this Resolution:

- c) "cultivar" means, following the definition of the 8th edition of the International Code of Nomenclature for Cultivated Plants, an assemblage of plants that (a) has been selected for a particular character or combination of characters, (b) is distinct, uniform, and stable in these characters, and (c) when propagated by appropriate means, retains those characters (but see Article 9.1 Note 1).

Article 9.1 Note 1 states that no new taxon of cultivated plants (including a cultivar) can be regarded as such until its category name and circumscription has been formally published.

***Regarding cultivars***

DETERMINES that:

Cultivars shall be subject to the provisions of the Convention unless excluded by a specific annotation in Appendix I, II or III;
