COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT

The following amendments to the Resolution were agreed:

Preamble

New paragraph to be entered immediately prior to the third 'AWARE', to read:

RECOGNIZING that the use of dogs in combination with other tools will increase the chance of detections and seizures; that detector dogs can detect items that can not be detected by other tools; and that a dog-handler team is highly effective in searching people and cargo or luggage in a short time.

Regarding communication of information and coordination

New paragraph i) (subsequent paragraphs to be re-numbered), to read:

Parties with existing detector-dog programmes share knowledge and experience with those Parties that may be interested in developing and implementing such programmes;

Regarding additional actions to promote enforcement

New paragraph a), v) (subsequent paragraphs to be re-numbered), to read:

using wildlife detector dogs;
