## Discussion forum on timber identification and physical inspection

- 1 In compliance with Decision 14.60, adopted at the 14th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (The Hague, 2007), the Secretariat has established an electronic working group on timber identification and physical inspection of timber shipments.
- 2. To assist the Working Group in its task, the Secretariat has created on its website a discussion forum to allow it to compile information on procedures adopted by Parties for:
  - a) the identification of CITES-listed and look-alike timber species; and
  - b) the physical inspection of shipments of CITES-listed timber species.
- 3. Only members of the Working Group have access to this forum. Membership in the group and access to the forum are provided by the Chair of the timber identification and physical inspection Working Group (Italy).
- 4. Parties and relevant intergovernmental organizations are invited to provide information on existing procedures for identification of CITES-listed timber species, as well as species similar in appearance, and physical inspection of shipments of CITES-listed timber species. They are further invited to indicate how information on those procedures can be accessed by CITES authorities.
