NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

CONCERNING:

Implementation of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13)
(Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species)

Recommendations of the Standing Committee

- 1. In the context of the Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species, the Standing Committee regularly recommends trade suspensions for countries that it has determined have failed to implement Article IV of the Convention. The Secretariat last published the list of countries and species affected by these recommendations with Notification to the Parties No. 2012/057 of 7 September 2012.
- 2. In Notification to the Parties No. 2012/057, the Secretariat announced that, because a recommendation made by the Plants Committee had not been complied with, the Standing Committee had decided to recommend a suspension of trade in specimens of Swietenia macrophylla from Belize. In fact, Belize had complied with the recommendation concerned within the required time limit. The recommendation to suspend trade was therefore made in error and the Secretariat apologizes for this misunderstanding.
- 3. The Annex to the present Notification contains an updated summary of all the Standing Committee's recommendations to suspend trade covered by Article IV of the Convention made in accordance with Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13) or Resolution Conf. 8.9 (Rev.), which it replaced.
- 4. Parties are reminded that the complete list of Parties subject to a recommendation to suspend trade is available on the CITES website under Documents/Trade suspensions.
- 5. In order not to undermine the recommendations of the Standing Committee, the Secretariat encourages Parties:
 - a) to take steps to ensure that they can effectively implement recommendations of the Standing Committee; and
 - b) not to authorize the re-export of any specimens imported against such recommendations.
- 6. Parties are requested to inform their Enforcement and Customs authorities of the availability of the list of trade suspension recommendations on the CITES website in order to avoid the inadvertent acceptance of specimens of species subject to such a recommendation. Parties that require the issuance of import permits for trade in specimens of Appendix-II species are also encouraged to consult the list when processing applications.
- 7. The present Notification replaces Notification to the Parties No. 2012/057.
