NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

Tibetan antelope (Pantholops hodgsonii)

1. At its 16th meeting (Bangkok, 2013), the Conference of the Parties adopted Decisions 16.93 and 16.94 on the "Tibetan antelope (*Pantholops hodgsonii*)", as follows:

Directed to the Parties

All Parties should immediately bring every seizure of illegal Tibetan antelope wool and its products made within its territory to the attention of authorities in countries of origin, transit and destination, as applicable, and to the attention of the Secretariat. Information on the seizure should be accompanied by available associated information, to enable follow-up investigations to take place. The progress of follow-up investigations should also be reported to the Secretariat.

Directed to the Secretariat

- 16.94 The Secretariat shall report information on seizures made and on the progress of investigations referred to in Decision 16.93 at the 65th meeting of the Standing Committee.
- 2. To date, no information on seizures has been received by the Secretariat. Parties are therefore invited to inform to the Secretariat of any seizures in accordance with Decision 16.93.
