Updated IATA Regulations for the Transport of Live Animals and Plants

- 1. The International Air Transport Association (IATA) has agreed to offer to CITES Parties a 15 per cent discount on the two following manuals:
 - a) Live Animals Regulations, 40th edition, effective 1 October 2013 to 31 December 2014

Accepted by CITES and recognized as the international standard for transport of live animals, the IATA *Live Animals Regulations* (LAR) is an essential source of information on how to ship animals safely, sensitively and cost-effectively. It specifies the minimum requirements for the international transport of animals, and indicates what precautions airlines, shippers, cargo agents and animal care professionals should take on the ground and in the air. It incorporates a new *Appendix G - CITES Guidelines for the Non-Air Transport of Live Wild Animals and Plants*. The Manual is available on CD-ROM in English, French and Spanish. The printed version is available in English only.

b) Perishable Cargo Regulations, 13th edition, effective 1 October 2013 to 31 December 2014

Accepted by CITES, the *Perishable Cargo Regulations* (PCR) is the reference guide for the preparation, packaging and handling of perishable goods to be transported by air. This manual has a special section about requirements and instructions for plant transportation, including cooling, shipping temperatures and storage guidelines.
