	<p>Comments: Indonesia has now established eight Post-confiscation Rescue Centers for handling the confiscated live animals. These are located in Jakarta, Bogor, Sukabumi, Yogyakarta, Malang, Bali, Ambon and North Sulawesi. The centers are developed and run in collaborative partnership between the Government and NGO's. Currently the Government is developing the standard operational procedures for the centers and procedures for post-rescue treatments of the animals held in the centers.</p> <p>Indonesia also has established pre- released Orangutan Rehabilitation Centers in East Kalimantan (Wanariset and Samboja Lestari); Central Kalimantan ( Pangkalan Bun and Nyaru Menteng); North Sumatera ( Sibolangit ) and Jambi Province ( Bukit Tiga Puluh).</p>

13	<p>If Yes, please give a brief description:</p> <p>Bilateral cooperation between Indonesia and the Philippines on bird trade</p> <p>A meeting between the Government of Indonesia and the Philippines was held and facilitated by Haribon Foundation (Philippines) and BirdLife Indonesia in Davao City the Philippines on 24-25 June 2004. This meeting was aimed to find solutions on the problem of illegal trade which occurs in this two countries to find solutions on the problem of illegal trade in bird species which occurs in this two countries. A number of solutions were agreed upon, including: increased dialogue between two countries; further CITES training for enforcement personnel; follow-up meetings to address problems as they arise; and repatriation of Indonesian birds confiscated in the Philippines. A detailed agreement and action plan will be developed, and the next meeting will be organized in Indonesia (probably in Manado, North Sulawesi).</p> <p>A tri-national (Indonesia-Malaysia-Singapore) workshop on the conservation of and trade in ramin (<i>Gonystylus</i> spp.) was organized by TRAFFIC South East Asia in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The workshop aimed to find solutions on the problem of illegal trade which occurs in this three countries. This workshop also discussed the recommendations made by previously held national workshops (in Indonesia and in Malaysia). One of the recommendations made in this tri-national workshop was the formation of a taskforce which consists of officials from the three countries to deal with enforcement on ramin timber trade.</p>

1. =  In collaboration with WWF Indonesia The Management Authority organized two training workshops on Control of Trade in Wild Endangered Species in 9 April 2003 in Jakarta and 21-21 April 2003 in Bali. The Training Workshop aimed to discuss and find solution on CITES issues in order to implement better control of trade in wild fauna and flora. The workshop were held in coincidence with the launching and dissemination of Identification Guide Book on Indonesian Protected Animals. The workshop was attended by field officers from Quarantine, Customs, Police, Fisheries officials, Forestry			

officials and Provincial Conservation Units. The Jakarta workshop was intended for the officials of such agencies coming from western part of Indonesia, while Bali workshop was intended for the officials from the central and eastern parts of Indonesia.

Some 100 personnel were involved in the training workshops in two places. It was agreed that workshop like this should be periodically organised in order to provide wider knowledge in CITES and wildlife trade control.

*Regular (annual) Training on CITES*

Regular (annual) Training on CITES Law Enforcement for field enforcement officers such as Customs, Quarantine and Provincial Conservation Agencies is conducted annually. The training has been undertaken regularly since 1995 to enhance the skill and knowledge of the field officers on CITES in order to implement better control of trade in wild fauna and flora. The training materials include Introduction to Species Conservation, Introduction to CITES, Permit Systems and Procedures, Wildlife Crime and Law Enforcement Procedures, Customs Procedures, Quarantine Procedures and Species and Specimens Identification.
