Annotation Transfer from Appendix I to Appendix II of the vicuña population of Ecuador, for the exclusive purpose of allowing international trade in wool sheared from live vicuñas and in cloth and items made thereof, including luxury handicrafts and knitted articles. The reverse side of the cloth must bear the logotype adopted by the range States of the species, which are signatories to the <i>Convenio para la Conservación y Manejo de la Vicuña</i> , and the selvages the words 'VICUÑA ECUADOR'. Other products must bear a label including the logotype and the designation 'VICUÑA ECUADOR-ARTESANÍA'.	Adopted with the addition of the sentence "All other specimens shall be deemed to be specimens of species included in Appendix I and the trade in them shall be regulated accordingly" at the end of the annotation.
