Subject: RE: CITES COP17 /// Proposals to amend CITES Appendices

In response to your request, the CCAMLR Secretariat does hold data for one of the taxa in the CITES list: reported to CCAMLR as *Alopias superciliosus*. We have 69 catch records with a total reported catch of 54 kg. The data are mostly from trawl surveys in Subarea 48.3 with two records from trawling activity in Division 58.5.2. There are 247 lengths reported from the survey data (range 7-21cm) and some sex and maturity data.

If additional information concerning these records is required by CITES it will be necessary for us to approach the data owners for permission to release those details.

I look forward to your response to this information.
