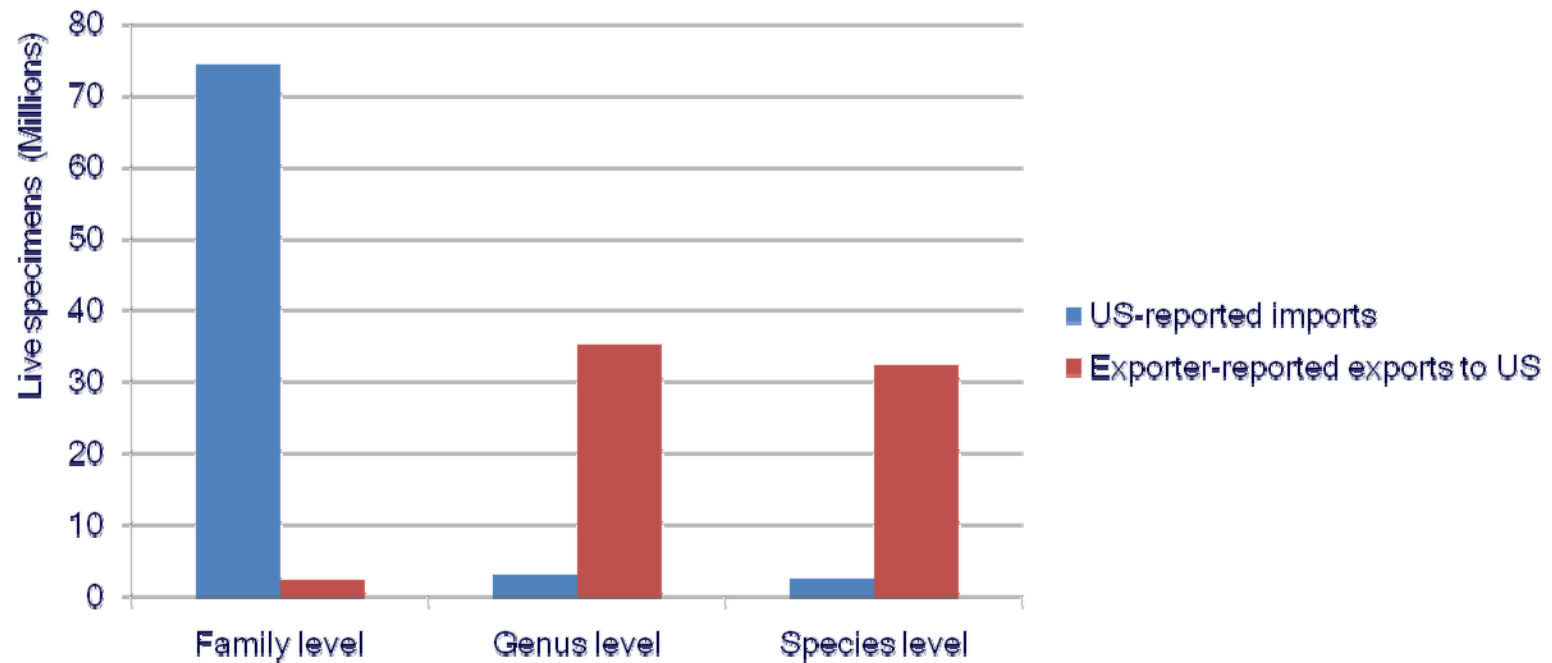

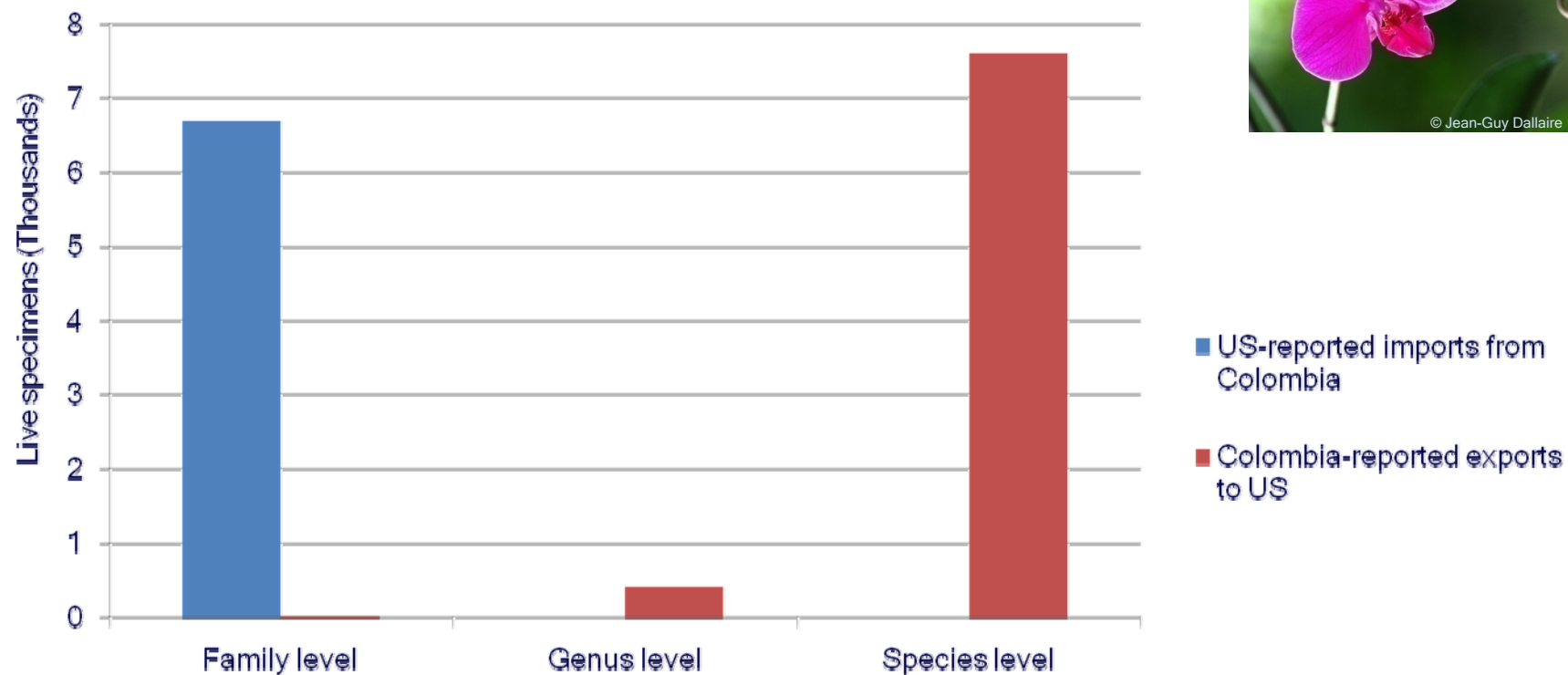

 - Trade data are only included in the CITES Trade Database if received in database-compatible electronic format

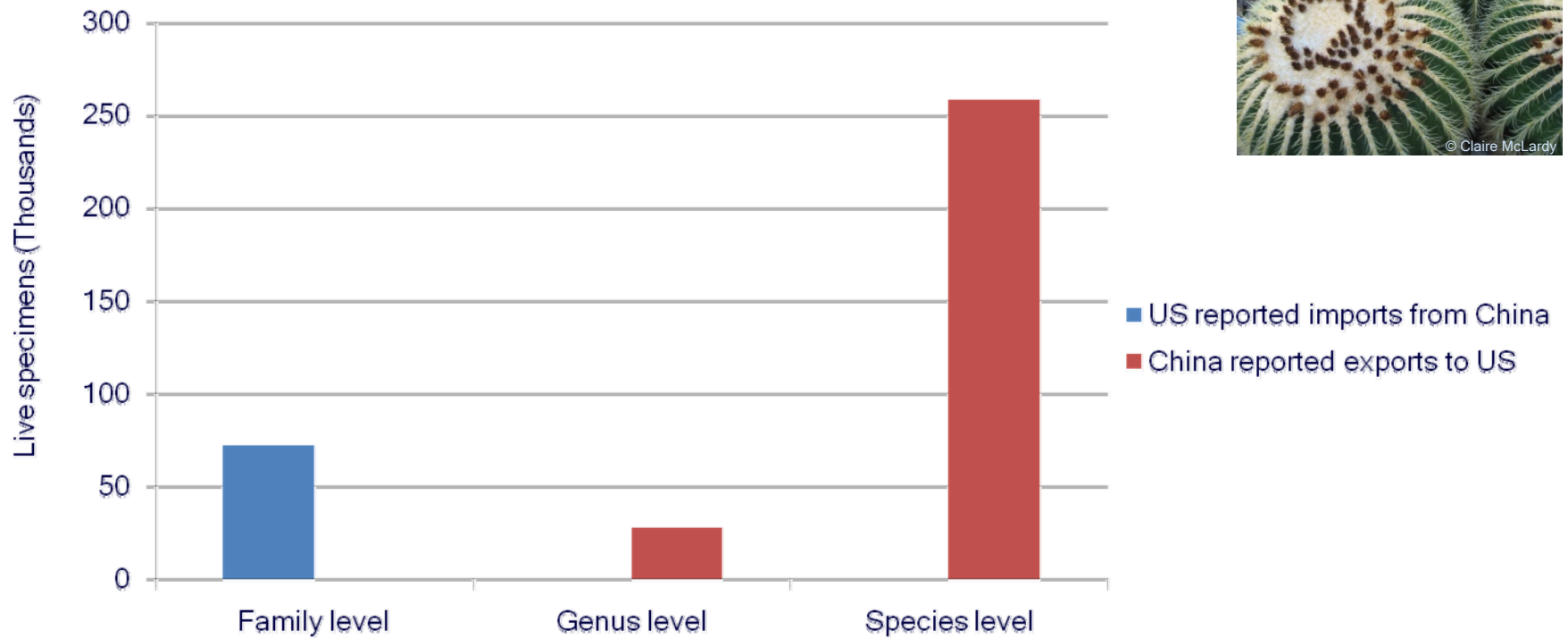

Direct imports of live artificially-propagated plants into the United States 2004-2006

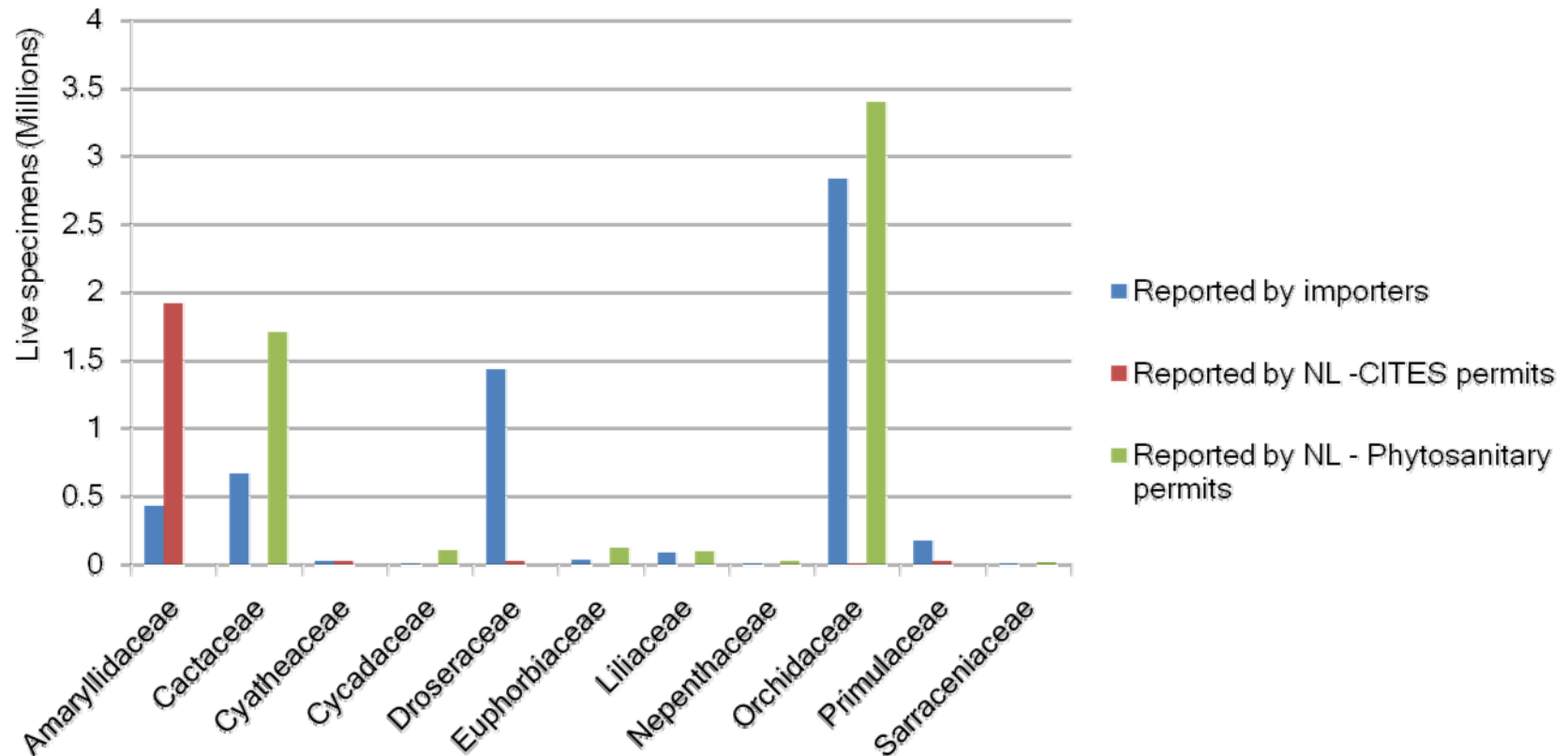


Direct imports of live artificially-propagated orchids from Colombia into the US in 2007
