ADMISSION OF OBSERVERS

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. In accordance with Rule 4, paragraph 2, of the Rules of Procedure of the Animals Committee, any body or agency technically qualified in protection, conservation or management of wild fauna and flora wishing to be represented at a meeting of the Committee by observers shall submit a request to the Secretariat at least 30 days before the meeting.
- 3. The above procedure does not apply to observers representing States not party to the Convention, nor to the United Nations, its Specialized Agencies or the International Atomic Energy Agency, which are entitled to be represented at meetings of the Animals Committee in accordance with Rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 4. The list of observers that have submitted a request to the Secretariat at least 30 days before the meeting to attend the 32nd meeting of the Animals Committee in accordance to Rules 3 and 4 of the Rules of Procedure and that have been approved by the Chair can be found below.
- 5. The Secretariat wishes to draw the Committee's attention to Rule 4, paragraph 1, of its Rules of Procedure that states that "any body or agency technically qualified in protection, conservation or management of wild fauna and flora" can express its desire to be represented at meetings of the Committee. Following queries from Management Authorities about which types of organizations are covered, the Secretariat notes that the established practice has been to recommend to the Chairs of the Plants and Animals Committees that they approve the participation of any body or agency technically qualified in protection, conservation or management of wild fauna and flora, as well as any body or agency that has a legitimate and direct interest in CITES regulations, including representatives of industries such as fragrance, medicinal plants, cosmetics, timber and musical instrument organizations and other trade organizations.
- 6. The Committee is invited to take note of the list of observers below and of the current practice of approval of observer organizations in accordance with Rule 4, paragraph 3, of its Rules of Procedure.
