ANIMALS COMMITTEE WORKPLAN

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Chair of the Animals Committee.*
- 2. The Annex to this document contains the list of instructions directed to the Animals Committee, or that may require that it be consulted or informed, that can be found in the currently valid Resolutions and Decisions of the Conference of the Parties. For ease of reference, and similar to meeting agendas of the Animals Committee, the Decisions are grouped under: Administrative and financial matters; Strategic matters; Compliance; Illegal trade and enforcement; Regulation of trade; Species conservation and trade; and Appendices of the Convention. The full text of these instructions is presented in document AC32 Doc. 8.1.
- 3. The Chair of the Animals Committee asked all Members and alternate Members of the Committee to review the above-mentioned instructions and consider how they each could contribute to achieving their effective implementation. The Animals Committee then identified a lead or co-leads for each of the instructions as part of its workplan for 2023-2025, as shown in the Annex to this document.
- 4. The Secretariat published Notification to the Parties No. <u>2023/044</u> on 5 April 2023 to inform the Parties that Mr. Thomas Leuteritz of the United States of America will replace Ms. Rosemarie Gnam as alternate representative for the North American region on the Animals Committee.

The Animals Committee is invited to note this document and agree that, in the event of the Standing Committee establishing additional intersessional working groups, the lead or co-leads identified for the relevant Resolution or Decision in the current work plan would represent the Animals Committee on the working group concerned.
