- 1. This document has been submitted by the Secretariat in relation with the election of new regional and alternate regional members for the Standing Committee (agenda items 9.1.2), Animals Committee (agenda item 9.2.2) and the Plants Committee (agenda item 9.3.2)*.
- On 14 April 2022, the Secretariat published Notification to the Parties No. 2022/026 reminding CITES Parties
 that the selection of regional Members and alternate regional Members of the Standing Committee and of
 the Animals and Plants Committees will take place at the regional meetings held during the 19th meeting of
 the Conference of the Parties. The Notification furthermore invited Parties to submit candidatures for
 membership of these Committees where vacancies exist.
- 3. On 29 August 2022, the Secretariat communicated the candidatures to the Parties of the six regions through e-mail correspondence. The *curriculum vitae* of the candidatures for the Animals and Plants Committees received from regions were also shared. A summary of the candidatures received is attached as an Annex to this document.
- 4. The regional meetings are scheduled to take place on 14 November 2022 from 14:30 to 17:30.
