Adoption of executive summary PC27 Sum. 3

The Committee adopted executive summary PC27 Sum. 3 with the following amendments:

- under agenda item 9, the amendments under b) ii) should read as follows: “amendment of the title of the Annex as follows: “List of potential CITES activities and products and their contribution to the objectives, and targets and complementary voluntary actions of the ~~updated~~ Global Strategy for Plant Conservation ~~2023-2030~~; and”
- under agenda item 9, the amendments under b) iii) should read as follows: “maintaining the last table in the Annex that maps the *Global Strategy for Plant Conservation* (~~GSPC~~) objectives, ~~GSPC~~ targets and CITES potential contribution;”
- under agenda item 33.2, the second paragraph should read as follows: “The membership of the working group ~~Committee~~ included Mexico.

Adoption of executive summary PC27 Sum. 4

The Committee adopted executive summary PC27 Sum. 4 with the following amendments:

- in Annex 2, delete the whole section (including the table) for 9. *Aquilaria crassna* / Viet Nam and for 11. *Aquilaria malaccensis* / Malaysia, the short term action i) should refer to an “interim export quota” and not a “zero export quota”.
- under agenda item 42, the conclusion should read: “The Committee noted the oral reports and documents PC27 Doc. 42.2 (Rev. 1) to PC27 Doc. ~~24.6.~~ 42.6.”
