

Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species (Resolution Conf. 12.8 and Decision 12.75)

SELECTION OF SPECIES FOR REVIEW

- 1. The Annex to this document has been prepared by UNEP-WCMC.
- 2. In accordance with paragraph b) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 on the Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species, the Animals Committee should select species of priority concern with the aim of identifying problems and solutions concerning the implementation of Article IV, paragraphs 2 (a), 3 and 6(a), of the Convention. The selection should be based on recorded trade levels and information available to the Animals Committee, the Secretariat, Parties or other relevant experts.
- 3. The Secretariat has requested UNEP-WCMC to provide a summary of trade data in Appendix-II animal species over the five most recent years, and guidance on the selection of species for review.
- 4. The Animals Committee is required to consider the document *Review of Significant Trade Analysis of Trade Trends with notes on the conservation status of selected species Volume 2. Animals*, by UNEP-WCMC (see the Annex to this document, English only) and to recommend a short list of species for its Review of Significant Trade.
