ADDENDUM TO QUOTAS FOR LEOPARD HUNTING TROPHIES

- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
- 2. On 15 January 2020, the Secretariat wrote to Botswana, the Central African Republic and Ethiopia, the three Parties identified in Decision 18.165, requesting them to review their leopard hunting quotas as contained in Resolution Conf. 10.14 (Rev. CoP16) on Quotas for leopard hunting trophies and skins for personal use, and to consider whether they are set at levels which are non-detrimental to the survival of the species in the wild.
- 3. In 2020, Botswana and Ethiopia provided relevant information for consideration by the Animals Committee. This information is provided in Annex 1 and Annex 2 to document AC31 Doc. 29.2.
- 4. In February 2021, the Central African Republic submitted relevant information, which is provided in Annex 3, in the format and language as received.

Revised recommendation

- 5. The Animals Committee is invited to implement Decision 18.167 by:
 - a) considering the information submitted by the leopard range States concerned by Decision 18.165 in Annexes 1, 2 and 3 to document AC31 Doc. 29.2 and its addendum and any other relevant information; and
 - if necessary, making any recommendations to the range States and to the Standing Committee relating to the review.
