Interpretation and implementation of the Convention

PERSONAL AND HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS

1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.
2. Decision 13.71 directs the Standing Committee, in consultation with the Secretariat, Parties and relevant organizations, to:

*develop a process for consideration of specimens of personal and household effects of Appendix-II species which may need to have quantitative limits set to be exempted from permitting requirements according to Article VII, paragraph 3, of the Convention at the 14th meeting of the Conference of the Parties.*

Recommendation

3. The Secretariat recommends that the Standing Committee establish a working group on personal and household effects to assist it with implementation of Decision 13.71.
