EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

MORNING

The Committee <u>adopted</u> the executive summary of the fifth session of the meeting contained in document SC62 Sum. 5, without amendment.

The Committee <u>adopted</u> the executive summary of the sixth session of the meeting contained in document SC62 Sum. 6, with the following amendments:

- Under item 34, the following text is appended: <u>and recommended that the United States of America take</u> into account the suggestions of several Parties and their offers to cooperate on the preparation of a <u>document for CoP16</u>.
- Under item 43, the following text is appended:

and agreed that the Secretariat would issue a Notification to Parties reminding them of their reporting obligations, to enable a full assessment at CoP16. That Notification should stress that information is required for all Asian big cats. It would also stress the need for information relating to compliance with Decision 14.69, by requesting:

- a) All Parties with intensive operations breeding tigers on a commercial scale to fully implement Decision 14.69 in respect of the number of breeding operations and also for the total number of tigers; and
- b) All Parties to declare stockpiles of captive-bred or confiscated tiger body parts and derivatives along with actions proposed to deal with the stockpiles.

The Committee <u>adopted</u> the executive summary of the seventh session of the meeting contained in document SC62 Sum. 7, with the following amendment:

- Under item 47, in the second sentence, the word "decided" is replaced by the words <u>endorsed the</u> proposals made by the working group during the meeting, as detailed in document SC62 Inf. 13, which included.

The Committee <u>accepted</u> the report of the Working Group on this subject, contained in document SC62 Com. 2, and <u>endorsed</u> the recommendations in its Annex, with an amendment to the first recommendation, which should read as follows:

The working group recommends that the Standing Committee instruct the Secretariat to issue a Notification to the Parties regarding the possibility of illegal trade in snakes in Asia, using any relevant information provided by the Parties and relevant organizations at the Guangzhou workshop, as well as any other information available and deemed appropriate before the end of the year.

The Committee <u>accepted</u> the report of the Working Group on this subject, contained in document SC62 Doc. 49 (Rev. 1), and <u>endorsed</u> its recommendations, including a series of non-substantive amendments made orally and to be forwarded to the Secretariat.
