Welcome to Geneva!

To guide you throughout the meeting, we have assembled the information below.

## Visa information

Participants requiring a Schengen visa for Switzerland are strongly advised to contact the nearest Swiss diplomatic representation **as soon as possible, particularly in this year-end period,** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Notification to the Parties No. 2015/053 of 14 September 2015 will serve as the invitation letter, to be attached to the visa application.

# Arriving in Switzerland (Geneva Cointrin International Airport/GVA)

Geneva is serviced by the Geneva Cointrin International Airport (GVA), which is about 5 kilometres from central Geneva. Some hotels offer free shuttle service from the airport, so kindly request this information when making your reservation. There are direct connections to the city centre by taxi, train and bus, as follows:

## Taxi

Taxis are readily available at the Geneva Airport. The trip to central Geneva takes approx. 15 min. Fares range from CHF 35-/CHF40 (approx.)

## Train

The airport railway station has direct access to the airport check-in and arrival levels. All trains from the airport stop at the Geneva-Cornavin station in the city centre and the journey takes about 7 min (every 12 min). ## Bus

There are a number of bus lines that service the GVA Airport. The frequency and fares are as follows:

- a) To Geneva Railway Station: Bus number 10 departs approx. every 10 min;
- b) **To Geneva Place des Nations** (United Nations' Building): Bus number 5 departs approx. every 10 min. The CICG is located just off the Place des Nations.

You can pick up a free ticket for public transportation at the airport from the machine in the baggage collection area. With this "Unireso" ticket offered by the Geneva Cointrin International Airport, you can use public transport in Geneva for free for a period of 80 min.

If you are staying in a hotel in Geneva for the duration of your stay, **Geneva public transport (TPG) networks are FREE.** Just ask for the TPG pass in the establishment where you stay.
