PERIODIC REVIEW OF THE APPENDICES:  
REPORT OF THE ANIMALS AND PLANTS COMMITTEES

1. This document has been submitted by the Chairs of the Animals and Plants Committees.\*
2. In [Resolution Conf. 14.8 \(Rev. CoP17\)](#) on *Periodic review of species included in Appendices I and II*, the Conference of the Parties agrees on a process and guidelines for the Animals and Plants Committees to undertake a periodic review of animal or plant species included in the CITES Appendices, and directs the Chairs of the Animals and Plants Committees to keep the Standing Committee informed about the conduct of periodic reviews.
3. In accordance with paragraph 2 c) of Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), the Animals and Plants Committees initiated the review period at their first meetings after the 17th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP17), based on outputs prepared in accordance with subparagraph 2 b) of the Resolution [i.e. trade data and analysis for the period 2006-2015 prepared at the request of the Secretariat by the World Conservation Monitoring (UNEP-WCMC)]. The Committees identified a list of taxa to be considered for periodic review during the next two intersessional periods, i.e. between CoP17 and the 19th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP19) in 2022.

Species selected for review by the Animals Committee

4. At its 29th meeting (AC29, Geneva, July 2017), the Animals Committee considered the information contained in document [AC29 Doc. 33.2 \(Rev. 1\)](#), and identified twenty candidate animal species for potential review under Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17). The species, as well as the Appendices in which they are included and their range States are shown in the table below. Where a range State has already volunteered to conduct the review, this is indicated in **bold**.

#### Species selected for review by the Plants Committee

5. At its 23rd meeting (PC23, Geneva, July 2017), the Plants Committee considered document [PC23 Doc. 29.2](#) and identified seven plant species for potential periodic review in accordance with Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17). The species, as well as the CITES Appendix in which they are included and the range States concerned, are shown in the table below. Where a range State has volunteered to conduct the review, this is indicated in **bold**.

#### Other considerations

6. The Animals and Plants Committees express the need for external funding in [AC29 Com. 7 \(Rev. by Sec.\)](#) and [PC23 Com. 1 \(Rev. by Sec.\)](#) specifically for the Periodic Review process, including providing support to range States for conducting the reviews.
7. The Scientific Committees recommend that Outputs 1 in the Annexes to documents [AC29 Doc. 33.2 \(Rev.1\)](#) and [PC23 Doc. 29.2](#) be referred to the Secretariat and the Standing Committee for further consideration. These outputs are shown in Annexes 1 and 2 to this document. They contain information concerning Appendix-I listed species where commercial trade has been recorded from wild-sources (source codes W, R and U, and no source reported) during the period 2006-2015, which may be contrary to the provisions of the Convention.
8. In accordance with paragraph 2 d) of Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP17), the Secretariat will issue a Notification, in October, to inform all Parties of the proposed list of taxa to be reviewed, and to request range States of the taxa to comment within 60 days on whether they support a review of the taxa and express their interest in undertaking the reviews.

Recommendation

9. The Standing Committee is invited to:

- a) note this document;
- b) request its Finance and Budget Sub-Committee to consider allocating funds specifically for the Periodic Review process, including support to range States for conducting such reviews,
- c) consider the information contained in Annexes 1 and 2 to the current document concerning reported commercial trade from wild-sources (W, R, U and no source reported) over the period 2006-2015.
