- 1. This document has been prepared by the Secretariat.

- 3. It should be noted that the right-hand column of the draft agenda currently indicates the Resolutions and Decisions that are relevant to the agenda item and the source from which a report is expected. In the provisional agenda to be issued for the meeting, however, this column will instead indicate the document numbers.
- 4. The current draft of the agenda contains only items for which a discussion is expected by virtue of the text of the Convention or an instruction in a Resolution or Decision. Obviously, the draft agenda is subject to change, depending on the documents (and, hence, agenda items) that are submitted by Parties, the CITES Committees or the Secretariat. In accordance with Resolution Conf. 4.6 (Rev. CoP17) on Submission of draft resolutions and other documents for meetings of the Conference of the Parties, the deadline for communicating documents to the Secretariat is 150 days before the meeting i.e. in the case of CoP18 the relevant date is 24 December 2018. This date has already been conveyed to Parties through Notification to the Parties No. 2017/0072 of 14 December 2017.
