to contracting or signatory states of the Convention on
International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna
and Flora

AMENDMENTS TO APPENDICES I AND II OF THE CONVENTION

- A. In accordance with the provisions of Article XV, paragraph 1(a), of the Convention, Australia, Austria, Bangladesh, Brazil, Chile, China, Costa Rica, Denmark, the Federal Republic of Germany, France, India, Indonesia, Malawi, Mozambique, Nepal, Norway, Seychelles, Suriname, Sweden, Switzerland, Tunisia, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the United States of America all Parties to the Convention, have communicated to the Secretariat the following proposals for amendment of Appendices I and II of the Convention. e. fruits and parts and derivatives thereof of naturalized or artificially propagated Cactaceae spp., and separate stem joints (pads) and parts and derivatives thereof of naturalized or artificially propagated Opuntia spp.

B. In accordance with Resolution Conf. 2.17 adopted by the Conference of the Parties at its second meeting (San José, 1979), most of the above-mentioned proposals for amendment were accompanied by supporting statements presented under the agreed format. For contracting states, these statements are attached to the present Notification. Taking into account the volume of the documentation received and in order to avoid too long delays for communicating the proposals for amendment, most of the supporting statements are transmitted in their original form. Final documents translated into the working languages for the meeting of the Conference of the Parties will be communicated at a later stage.

C. In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 1(a), 2(b) and 2(c) of Article XV of the Convention, the above proposals are communicated to the Parties for comments. Since the responses have to be communicated to all Parties not later than 30 days before the meeting of the Conference, the Secretariat would appreciate receiving Parties' responses, if any, as soon as possible and not later than 20 January 1985. The views expressed and data provided by inter-governmental bodies having a function in relation to marine species, as well as the Secretariat's recommendations will be communicated to the Parties as soon as possible.

- D. The present Notification, without supporting statements, is being sent for information to the signatory states which are not Party to the Convention. They will also receive the result of the consideration which will take place during the fifth meeting of the Conference of the Parties.
- E. The Secretariat would appreciate the contents of the present Notification being transmitted to the competent national authorities.
