2. Biological Data

21. Distribution: Thailand: Known only from Bung Boraphet in Nakhon Sawan Province (winter only) from where the species was discovered and described in 1968.
22. Population: Thailand: Rare, presumably a migrant from the North. Not included in the 1979 ICBP/IUCN Red Data Book.

There is no captive population.

23. Habitat: Reeds of marshes, (rivers ?).

3. Trade Data

31. National Utilization: None.
32. Legal International Trade: Has never been recorded in trade since 1975.
33. Illegal Trade: No evidence.
34. Potential Trade Threats: None

4. Protection Status

CITES history: Listed at Washington, D.C., 1973 following a proposal by Thailand. Has never been reviewed.

5. Information on Similar Species

Difficult to identify in the field. P. sirintarae was described in 1968 only.

There is no ID Manual sheet available.
