DRAFT RESOLUTION OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES

Amendments to Resolution Conf. 12.9 on Personal and household effects

1. Add to paragraph b) under RECOMMENDS, the following new subparagraphs v) and vi):
 - v) specimens of unworked dead corals, as defined in Resolution Conf. 11.10 (Rev. CoP12), of *Helioporidae*, ~~*Scleractinia*~~, *Milleporidae*, *Scleractinia*, *Stylasteridae* and *Tubiporidae* spp. excluding *Antipatharia* spp. (black corals) – up to ~~six~~ four pieces, not exceeding 1 kilogram in total, per person;
 - vi) ~~shells of giant clam (*Tridacnidae* spp.) one~~ dead specimen, which may be one intact shell or two matching halves, ~~(i.e. one intact shell or two matching halves)~~ not exceeding 1 kilogram per person. ~~The meat is not included in this exemption.~~
2. Delete the paragraph under REQUESTS.
