How to get from hotels to the *Centre international de conférences de Genève (CICG)*15 rue de Varembé –1211 Geneva 20

Hôtel Ascot

From the main road "Rue de Lausanne" and the nearest bus stop 'Butini', take bus no. 4 to the train station (towards 'Gare Cornavin') and get off at the train station (3rd stop). At the train station take bus no. 5 (towards 'Palexpo') and get off at 'Varembé' (4th stop, approximately 10 minutes).

Hôtel Chantilly

From the main road "Rue de Lausanne" and the nearest bus stop 'Zurich', take bus no. 4 to the train station (towards 'Gare Cornavin') and get off at the train station (1st stop). You can also walk to the station. At the train station take bus no. 5 (towards 'Palexpo') and get off at 'Varembé' (4th stop, approximately 10 minutes).

Hôtel Royal and Auteuil

Outside the hotel on the "rue de Lausanne", take bus no. 4 to the train station (towards 'Gare Cornavin') and get off at the train station (1st stop). You can also walk to the station. At the train station take bus no. 5 (towards Palexpo) and get off at 'Varembé' (4th stop, approximately 10 minutes).

Hôtel Mon repos

Take bus no. 11 (towards 'Gare Eaux Vives'); get off at 'UIT' (2nd stop, approximately 5 minutes.). You will see signs indicating UIT and CICG.

On foot: (approximately 15 minutes) Take "Avenue de la Paix" up to "Place des Nations" (where you will see a huge three-legged chair), turn left and then left again down to the second pedestrian crossing, cross the road and walk down the "rue de Varembé" for about 300 m.

Hôtel Les Nations

On foot: (approximately 5 minutes) on leaving the hotel, turn left and then left again and walk down the "rue de Vermont" for approximately 300 m.

Public transport

A bus ride is CHF 2.20 for one hour and CHF 1.80 for 30 minutes. Changes of bus lines and returns to the starting point are permitted within these periods. Tickets are exclusively sold by vending machines at each bus stop. You can either pay with coins (with the exact change) or by card (CHF 10, 20, etc., available from newsagents).
