Translation of the CITES e-permitting toolkit

- 1. In Resolution Conf. 12.3 (Rev. CoP16) on *Permits and certificates*, the Conference of the Parties recommends that "Parties using or developing electronic permits and certificates adopt the standards recommended in the *CITES electronic permitting toolkit*" (under *Regarding standardization of CITES permits and certificates*, paragraph c).
- 2. Version 2 of the CITES electronic permitting toolkit was released on 2 March 2013. This version of the Toolkit is fully mapped with the World Customs Organization (WCO) Data Model and UN/CEFACT standards to assist Parties with the development of CITES e-permitting systems that are aligned with Single Windows environments.
- 3. To facilitate use of the *Toolkit* and promote adherence to CITES e-permitting standards, the *Toolkit* has been translated into French and Spanish. These translations are available on the CITES website at:
