NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

CONCERNING:

Amendment to Appendix III

 In accordance with the provisions of Article XVI, paragraph 1, of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, the following Parties have requested the Secretariat to include in Appendix III the species indicated below:

Brazil FLORA

MELIACEAE Cedrela fissilis^{#5}

Cedrela lilloi#5

Senegal FLORA

LEGUMINOSAE

(Fabaceae) Pterocarpus erinaceus^{#1}

- #1 means that parts and derivatives are included, except:
 - a) seeds, spores and pollen (including pollinia);
 - b) seedling or tissue cultures obtained *in vitro*, in solid or liquid media, transported in sterile containers;
 - c) cut flowers of artificially propagated plants; and
 - d) fruits, and parts and derivatives thereof, of artificially propagated plants of the genus Vanilla.
- #5 means that the only parts and derivatives are logs, sawn wood and veneer sheets.
- 2. In accordance with the provisions of Article XVI, paragraph 2, of the Convention, inclusion of these species in Appendix III shall take effect 90 days after the date of this Notification, i.e. on 9 May 2016.
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of Article XVI, paragraph 3, of the Convention, the Government of Honduras has withdrawn the following species from Appendix III:

Honduras FAUNA

AVES

ANSERIFORMES

Anatidae Cairina moschata

- 4. In accordance with the provisions of Article XVI, paragraph 3, of the Convention, the withdrawal of this species from Appendix III shall take effect 30 days after the date of this Notification, i.e. on 10 March 2016.
- The revised edition of the CITES Appendices will be placed on the CITES website before it enters into effect.
