Withdrawal of a recommendation to suspend trade

- 1. In Notification to the Parties No. 2016/024 of 16 March 2016, the Secretariat informed Parties that, pursuant to Resolution Conf. 11.17 (Rev. CoP17)*, the Standing Committee had recommended that Parties not authorize trade in specimens of CITES-listed species with Sao Tome and Principe as it had failed, without having provided adequate justification, to provide annual reports for three consecutive years.
- 2. The Secretariat has since received from Sao Tome and Principe its annual reports for the years 2011 to 2015.
- 3. The Secretariat therefore informs Parties that the recommendation to suspend trade in specimens of CITES-listed species with Sao Tome and Principe is withdrawn with immediate effect.
