Master's course on Management and Conservation of Species
in Trade: the International Framework

1. The Secretariat is pleased to circulate the information below at the request of the Management Authority of Spain.
2. The International University of Andalusia is organizing the 13th edition of its Master's course on Management and Conservation of Species in Trade: the International Framework.
3. In the 12 previous courses, over 300 students from 90 countries have received specialized training on the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) and on the current issues related to the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity.
4. The attached documents (available in English only) contain detailed information on the Master's course, including course structure, schedule, fees, scholarships, and the requisite application forms.
5. The Master's course is open to 30 graduate students with university degrees. The deadline for pre-registration phase is 1 December 2017. The enrolment period is open up to 15 January 2018 (subject to availability).
6. Parties are encouraged to present candidates to the 13th edition of the Master's course to continue strengthening their national capacity to implement the Convention more effectively.
