CONCERNING:

Countries directly affected by a document
submitted for the 69th meeting of the Standing Committee

1. According to Rule 21, paragraph 3, of the Rules of Procedure of the Standing Committee,

When the Secretariat believes that a Party may be directly affected by any discussion of a document to be considered by the Committee, it shall alert the Party concerned and inform it where the document may be viewed on the CITES website. It shall provide printed documents to all Parties that request them.

2. Considering the breadth and coverage of the agenda of the 69th meeting of the Standing Committee (SC69) and the high volume of documents submitted, virtually every Party is likely to be concerned by at least one document submitted for SC69. As a consequence, the Secretariat will not be writing individually to each of its 183 Parties and encourages Parties to study the agenda and documents for the meeting at: <https://cites.org/eng/com/sc/69/index.php>
