CONCERNING:

Proposals to amend Appendices I and II

Consultation with range States

1. This Notification is being published at the request of Mexico.
2. In Resolution Conf. 8.21 (Consultation with range States on proposals to amend Appendices I and II), the Conference of the Parties recommends that Parties intending to submit proposals to amend Appendices I or II should consult with range States.
3. With regard to proposals to be submitted for the consideration of the 18th meeting of the Conference of the Parties that will take place in Colombo, Sri Lanka, from 23rd May to 3rd June 2019, Mexico has informed the Secretariat that it intends to submit a proposal to include the species *Isurus oxyrinchus* and *Isurus paucus* in Appendix II.
4. Accordingly, Mexico requests range States to provide any available information on the conservation status (distribution, population size, structure, and trends), and on legal domestic and international trade of specimens, parts, and derivatives, as well as information on illegal trade (seizures and confiscations). We would be grateful if this information could be sent by 12th November 2018, if possible.
5. In order to enable Mexico to submit a revised proposal at least 150 days prior to the 18th meeting of the Conference of the Parties, i.e., by 24th December 2018, the information should be sent directly to the Mexican Management Authority, by 15th November, at the latest, to the following address:
