



NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

CONCERNING:

Results of the 18th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP18)

- 1. The Secretariat detailed the amendments to the Appendices agreed at CoP18 in Notification to the Parties No. 2019/052 of 3 October 2019 and provided a copy of the new Appendices themselves in Notification to the Parties No. 2019/055 of 16 October 2019.
- 2. In accordance with the provisions of Article XV, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph (c), of the Convention, the amendments adopted at CoP18 enter into force 90 days after that meeting, i.e. on 26 November 2019, for all Parties except those which make reservations in accordance with paragraph 3 of that Article.
- 3. Consequently, the Secretariat has today posted the final new Appendices on the CITES website. The Secretariat draws the attention of Parties to a small number of changes to the text of the version circulated with Notification to the Parties No 2019/052 which are detailed in the annex to the present Notification. These were required to address certain linguistic and translation issues drawn to the attention of the Secretariat by Parties. Further and in accordance with paragraph 4 of Resolution Conf. 12.11 (Rev. CoP17) on Standard Nomenclature, Parties are invited to note that following consultation with the Chair of the Animals Committee, an orthographic change has been made to the Appendices, so that Ovis hodgsonii is written Ovis hodgsoni.
- 4. The new, revised and continued Decisions adopted at CoP18 were posted on the CITES website on 9 November 2019 and the new and revised Resolutions on 15 November. In accordance with paragraph 7 of Resolution Conf. 4.6 (Rev. CoP18) the recommendations contained in these Resolutions and Decisions enter into effect 90 days after the meeting at which they are adopted, i.e. on 26 November 2019, unless otherwise specified in the recommendation concerned.
