## Questionnaire on the development of an Integrated CITES capacity-building framework

- 1. At its 18th meeting (Geneva, 2019), the Conference of the Parties adopted Decisions 18.39 to 18.46 on *Capacity-building* whereby the Standing Committee is mandated to undertake the following:
  - 18.41 The Standing Committee shall establish a working group on capacity-building to advise the Standing Committee on the actions outlined in Decisions 18.42 and 18.43 for the development of an integrated capacity-building framework to improve implementation of the Convention.

- 18.42 The Standing Committee shall provide guidance to the Secretariat to refine and consolidate the areas of capacity-building efforts, taking into account the discussions on the Compliance Assistance Programme and Country-wide Significant Trade Reviews, as well as the discussion on the development of an integrated capacity building framework...
- 2. Furthermore, the Secretariat has been tasked under Decision 18.46 to "develop a questionnaire and issue a Notification to Parties transmitting the questionnaire to gather input to inform the development of an integrated capacity-building framework".
- 3. In document CoP18 Doc. 21.3, the capacity-building framework is described as follows: "A framework that encompasses all capacity building to help address Parties' compliance and implementation issues can assist Parties and donors in identifying shared goals and performance indicators, and can provide a foundation for better planning and prioritization, and more efficient use of resources". It is further explained that it could be based on a "conceptual model" that illustrates how various components of CITES function to support legal and sustainable trade, and combat illegal trade, and a "resource tracking tool" to target and monitor capacity building to help address compliance and implementation issues. It may also include other tools or guidance.
- Accordingly, the Secretariat has developed the attached questionnaire based on document <u>CoP18 Doc. 21.3</u>
   Annex 5 and in consultation with the intersessional working group of the Standing Committee on capacity-building.
