CONCERNING:

Implementation of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP18) on Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species:

Recommendations of the Standing Committee

- In the context of the Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species, the Standing Committee regularly recommends trade suspensions for countries that it has determined to have failed to implement Article IV of the Convention. The Secretariat last published the list of countries and species affected by these recommendations following the 74th meeting of the Standing Committee (SC74, Lyon, March 2022) in Notification to the Parties No. 2022/028 of 28 April 2022.
- 2. In addition to the updates reported in Notification to the Parties No. 2022/028, the Standing Committee, at SC74, had recommended that the suspension of trade in *Plerogyra simplex* and *P. sinuosa* from Fiji; and *Kinyongia fischeri* and *K. tavetana* from the United Republic of Tanzania could be withdrawn, subject to the publication of zero export quotas. The Secretariat wrote to both Parties on 20 April 2022 but had received no response at the time of publication of the notification. Therefore, the recommendations to suspend trade were retained at that time.
- 3. The Secretariat wrote to both Parties again on 2 February 2023 and received confirmation of the zero export quotas. The recommendations to suspend trade in *Plerogyra simplex* and *P. sinuosa* from Fiji; and *Kinyongia fischeri* and *K. tavetana* from the United Republic of Tanzania have therefore been withdrawn in accordance with the Standing Committee instructions. Recalling the provisions of paragraph k) i) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP18) on *Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species*, it is noted that any change to these zero quotas should be communicated to the Secretariat and Chair of the Animals Committee along with a justification (including an NDF), for their agreement.
- 4. At the 19th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP19, Panama, November 2022), the Parties adopted changes to the *Tridacna* nomenclatural references, such that *Tridacna* ningaloo is no longer recognized as a separate species, but as a synonym of *T. noae*. The RST-related suspensions of trade in *Tridacna* spp. from Solomon Islands have been amended to reflect this.
- 5. Parties are reminded that the complete list of Parties subject to a recommendation to suspend trade is available on the CITES website under Documents / Trade suspensions.
- 6. Parties are requested to inform their enforcement and Customs authorities of the availability of the list of trade suspension recommendations on the CITES website in order to avoid the inadvertent acceptance of specimens of species subject to such a recommendation. Parties that require the

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issuance of import permits for trade in specimens of Appendix-II species are also encouraged to consult the list when processing applications.

7. The present Notification replaces Notification to the Parties No. 2022/028 of 28 April 2022.

The Standing Committee recommended to suspend trade in Calumma spp. and Furcifer spp. from Madagascar, with the exception of Calumma amber, C. ambreense, C. andringitraense, C. boettgeri, C. brevicorne, C. capuroni, C. crypticum, C. cucullatum, C. fallax, C. furcifer, C. gallus, C. gastrotaenia, C. glawi, C. globifer, C. guibei, C. guillaumeti, C. hafahafa, C. hilleniusi, C. jejy, C. linota, C. malthe, C. marojezense, C. nasutum, C. oshaughnessyi, C. parsonii, C. peltierorum, C. peyrierasi, C. tarzan, C. tsaratananense, C. tsycorne, C. vatosoa, C. vencesi and C. vohibola; and Furcifer angeli, F. antimena, F. balteatus, F. belalandaensis, F. bifidus, F. campani, F. lateralis, F. minor, F. monoceras, F. nicosiai, F. oustaleti, F. pardalis, F. petteri, F. rhinoceratus, F. timoni, F. tuzetae, F. verrucosus and F. willsii.
