CONCERNING:

Reservations with respect to the amendments to the Appendices of the Convention

The Depositary Government (Government of Switzerland) has informed the Secretariat that the
following reservations were entered with respect to the amendments to Appendices I and II
adopted at the 19th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP19, Panama City, 2022). The
Depositary Government has also informed the Secretariat of reservations entered with respect to
amendments to Appendix III as per Notifications to the Parties No. 2022/073 of 13 October 2022,
No. 2022/077 of 3 November 2022, No. 2022/081 of 25 November 2022 and No. 2023/011 of 3
February 2023.

- 2. Indonesia's reservation on the inclusion of Copsyhus malabaricus is valid until 25 November 2023 and will therefore be considered as withdrawn automatically as from 26 November 2023. Their reservation regarding Carcharhinidae spp. is valid for six months after the inclusion enters into effect, i.e. until 25 May 2024; therefore it will be considered as withdrawn as from 26 May 2024. The reservation regarding Thelenotα spp. is valid for twelve months after the inclusion enters into effect, i.e. until 25 May 2025; therefore it will be considered as withdrawn as from 26 May 2025.
- 3. Thailand's reservation on the inclusion of Carcharhinidae spp. is valid for a period of six years, i.e. until 25 November 2028; therefore it will be considered as withdrawn as from 26 November 2028.
- 4. The reservations of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on the inclusion in Appendix III of the CITES of Melopyrrha nigra and Tiaris canorus (Cuba), of Caribena versicolor (European Union) and of Conophytum spp., Mestoklema tuberosum, Raphionacme zeyheri. Crassothonna clavifolia, Othonna armiana Othonna cacalioides, Othonna euphorbioides, Othonna retrorsa, Tylecodon bodleyae, Tylecodon nolteei, Tylecodon reticulatus, Monsonia herrei, Monsonia multifida, Monsonia patersonii, Pelargonium crassicaule, Pelargonium triste, Adenia spinosa and Portutacaria pygmaea (South Africa), apply to the following territories¹ of the Party: Anguilla; Bermuda; British Antarctic Territory; Montserrat; Pitcairn, Henderson, Ducie and Oeno Islands; Tristan da Cunha; South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands²; Turks and Caicos

In accordance with the United Nations General Assembly Resolution on the Chagos archipelago (A/RES/73/295), paragraph 6, the Secretariat has not included the reference to the British Indian Ocean Territory mentioned by the Party in its notification to the Depositary.

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A dispute exists between the Governments of Argentina and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland concerning sovereignty over the Falkland Islands (Islas Malvinas). See UN editorial directive ST/CS/SER.A/42.

The reservation of the United Kingdom on the inclusion of *Daboia palaestinae* in Appendix III applies to the United Kingdom; Anguilla; Bermuda; British Antarctic Territory; Montserrat; Pitcairn, Henderson, Ducie and Oeno Islands; Tristan da Cunha; South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands²; Turks and Caicos Islands; UK Sovereign Base Areas; Bailiwick of Guernsey, the Bailiwick of Jersey; and the Isle of Man.

- 5. Except for the reservations mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 above, the above-listed reservations were all effective from 23 February 2023, the date on which the amendments to the CITES Appendices adopted at CoP19 entered into force. The reservation entered with respect to *Caribena versicolor* was effective from 11 January 2023, the date on which this amendment to Appendix III entered into force.
- 6. Japan's reservation on the inclusion of *Prionace glauca* was accompanied by the following declaration (see text below as received):
 - 1. Japan makes [this reservation] primarily due to the fact that those species do not meet the criteria for inclusion thereof in Appendix II, as concluded by the FAO Expert Advisory Panel for the assessment of proposals to amend Appendices I and II concerning commercially exploited aquatic species.
 - 2. Nonetheless, Japan is continuously committed to conservation and management of Prionace glauca on which it has made reservation through domestic regulations and/or cooperation with other countries and organizations such as relevant Regional Fisheries Management Organizations.
 - 3. Notwithstanding paragraph 3 of Article XV of CITES, upon exporting Prionace glauca to all countries including those which are not parties to CITES, Japan will voluntarily conduct procedures related to export permits that are required under CITES, in accordance with its relevant laws and regulations.
- 7. The Depositary Government has also informed the Secretariat that the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland that its reservation on Ctenophorus spp., Intellagama spp., Tympanocryptis spp., Carphodactylus spp., Nephrurus spp., Orraya spp., Phyllurus spp., Saltuarius spp., Strophurus spp., Underwoodisaurus spp., Uvidicolus spp., Egernia spp., Tiliqua multifasciata, Tiliqua nigrolutea, Tiliqua occipitalis, Tiliqua rugosa, Tiliqua scincoides intermedia, Tiliqua scincoides scincoides and Holacanthus limbaughi no longer applies to the British Virgin Islands and Great Britain.
- 8. Notice of these reservations and communications was transmitted officially to the Governments of the signatory and acceding States to the Convention through a Notification from the Depositary Government dated 8 March 2023 in conformity with Article XXV, paragraph 2 of the Convention.
