CONCERNING:

Online workshops on conservation of amphibians (Amphibia spp.)

- At its 19th meeting (CoP19; Panama City, 2022), the Conference of the Parties adopted <u>Decisions 19.197 to 19.199</u> on Conservation of amphibians (Amphibia spp.). In accordance with Decision 19.197, the Secretariat is preparing two online interdisciplinary workshops for CITES Authorities and other relevant authorities and stakeholders about amphibian species in international trade, with the following objectives:
 - a) identify amphibian species that are in international trade and evaluate whether certain species or groups should be recommended for possible listing in the Appendices;
 - b) share existing national legislation relevant to the trade in amphibians;
 - c) evaluate whether current levels of trade are compatible with the conservation of these species in the wild:
 - d) compile further data on harvesting levels of amphibians subject to high volumes of international trade:
 - e) explore the emerging threat of diseases to traded amphibians, including amphibian chytrid fungus and rana viruses; and
 - examine current enforcement efforts to deter and detect illegal and unreported trade and identify additional actions needed.
- 2. The online workshops on conservation of amphibians is made possible due to the generous contributions by the European Union and Switzerland.

Online sessions

3. The Secretariat hereby informs Parties that the decision to host two workshops was made to accommodate different time zones from which participants are expected to connect. Both workshops, each with two daily three-hour sessions, will cover the same issues, hence participants may choose which one to attend. Workshop sessions will take place as follows:
