

# NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

CONCERNING:

## Species selected as potential candidates for Periodic Review

- The 27th meeting of the Plants Committee (PC27; Geneva, July 2024) and the 33rd meeting of the Animals Committee (AC33; Geneva, July 2024) agreed to select the following species as candidates for potential review under [Resolution Conf.14.8 \(Rev. CoP19\)](#) on *Periodic Review of species included in Appendices I and II* during the next intersessional period until the 21st meeting of the Conference of the Parties (CoP21; 2028) [[PC27 Sum 3 \(Rev. 1\)](#) and [AC33 Sum 3](#)]:

2. In terms of paragraph 3 d) in Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP19), the Secretariat is sharing the proposed list of taxa to be reviewed with all Parties, and requests range States of the taxa to comment within 60 days on whether they support a review of the taxa and express their interest in undertaking the reviews.
3. The Secretariat requests Parties and especially range States of the species selected to submit their responses by email with the subject line “Notification 2024/084 Periodic review” to [info@cites.org](mailto:info@cites.org) with a copy to [dejana.radisavljevic@cites.org](mailto:dejana.radisavljevic@cites.org) by **29 September 2024**.
4. The Secretariat shall relay responses received from range States to the Animals and Plants Committees. If no volunteer offers to undertake a review within two intersessional periods between meetings of the Conference of the Parties, those taxa shall be deleted from the list of species to be reviewed.
5. The Secretariat would like to remind Parties that, in terms of paragraph 3 e) of Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP19), each review (ideally in the format of a proposal used to amend the Appendices) is to be submitted as a working document to the Animals or Plants Committee for review, clearly specifying the recommendation with reference to the criteria in Resolution Conf. 9.24 (Rev. CoP17) on *Criteria for amendment of Appendices I and II*. These reviews can be submitted to either the 34th or 35th meetings of the Animals Committee and the 28th or 29th meeting of the Plants Committee, scheduled to take place in 2026 and 2027 respectively.
6. Furthermore, the Secretariat draws the attention of Parties to paragraph 5 of Resolution Conf. 14.8 (Rev. CoP19) that contain some reflections on means to facilitate periodic reviews.
