



Electronic CITES Permitting System


- 1. The notification is issued at the request of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.
- 2. The CITES Management Authority of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela wishes to inform Parties about the implementation of the CITES electronic permitting system, which took effect on 20 August 2024.
- 3. The Ministry of People's Power for Ecosocialism announced the launch of electronic CITES permitting systems through its official channels.
- 4. The electronic CITES permitting system is available on https://sitdb.minec.gob.ve.
- 5. These electronic permits can be verified for authentication and authorized quantities by the authorities through a QR code or an alphanumeric code.
- 6. Regarding valid electronic signatures for the issuance of permits and certificates in accordance with Article IX (4) of the Convention and paragraph 3 q) of Resolution Conf. 12.3 (Rev. CoP18) on Permits and Certificates, the relevant information is attached with this notification.
- 7. The permit number for export and import of Appendix II species has been implemented.
- 8. Since the launch of the system, constant monitoring has been conducted.

User Registration




The user enters their basic data and registers in the system




In this option the user registers the formal data of their company. These data are the ones that will be printed on the CITES form.











The user selects the CITES modality required. Records the data linked to the request.


Tramitar CITES Importación

When the user uploads all the information required by the CITES application, they must notify MINEC

The CITES application formally enters the MINEC. The General Directorate of Biological Diversity assigns a Technician to evaluate the request.


Notificar Cancelar





The Technician comprehensively evaluates the CITES application. If there is no inconsistency in the request, he closes the procedure. The General Directorate of Biological Diversity authorizes the company to pay taxes and fees.

The company receives notification of the payments. Proceed to make these in the MINEC bank accounts.





The minec reconciles the payments made by the company. Upon completion of the bank reconciliation process, the company receives the approved CITES form in the Rulings/Resolutions section of the system.
