## African Elephant Fund: Eleventh call for proposals

- 1. This Notification is published at the request of the African Elephant Fund Secretariat.
- 2. The African Elephant Fund (AEF) is a multi-donor technical cooperation trust fund established in 2010 at the 14th Conference of the Parties (CoP14) to CITES to support the implementation of the African Elephant Action Plan (AEAP).
- 3. The AEF has launched the <u>eleventh round of call for proposals</u>, inviting African elephant range States to apply for funding. This funding supports projects aimed at implementing the revised AEAP (2023).
- 4. Project proposals should meet the following minimum requirements:
  - The project proposal must be submitted on or before the deadline;
  - The standard AEF project proposal template (English / French) must be used;
  - The project proposal must be linked to at least one or more of the AEAP objectives;
  - All project proposals must be submitted by a Competent Authority or be accompanied by a letter of endorsement from the Competent Authority of the range State. A Competent Authority is the national Government entity responsible for wildlife in the range State;
  - Project proposals for transboundary projects must have endorsement letters from all the Competent Authorities of the participating range States;
  - The duration of the proposed project should be equal to or greater than 9 months;
  - A two-page executive summary of the project proposal must be provided in both English and French.
- 5. Proposals should be submitted to the AEF Secretariat at <a href="mailto:unep-africanelephantfund@un.org">unep-africanelephantfund@un.org</a> by 15 March 2025 at 11:59PM East African Time (EAT).
