<p>Comments According to Georgian legislation, the extraction of snowdrop bulbs and Cyclamen tubers in the wild requires a license only in the case where the harvested plant material is subject to export. Prior to announcement of the action and, further, annually, the Scientific Authority establishes the export quota. The license for harvesting was issued by the Ministry of Economic Development of Georgia. The export permits for snowdrop bulbs are then issued by the Ministry of Environment Protection on the basis of the licence and the harvest/export quota.</p> <p>Harvest / Export quota for <i>Galanthus woronowii</i> was 15 000 000 bulbs in 2011 and 2012 annually.</p> <p>Harvest / export quota for <i>Cyclamen coum</i> was 250 000 tubers in 2012. However only 2100 tubers of <i>Cyclamen</i> tuber were exported in 2012. 1 permit issued to export 2000 tubers was not used.</p>

Resolution of the Government of Georgia #18, February 6, 2007, On Approval of the Regulation on the Rule and Conditions of Issuance of Permit to Export, Import, Re-export and Introduction from the Sea of the Specimens (their parts and derivatives) of the Species Included in the Appendices of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES)

1. According to the paragraph 11 of the Article 24 and paragraph 1 of the Article 40 of the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits, the Regulation on the Rule and Conditions of Issuance of Permit to Export, Import, Re-export and Introduction from the Sea of the Specimens (their parts and derivatives) of the Species Included in the Appendices of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) is to be approved.
 - 1¹. Annexes #1 and #2 to be approved as attached versions.
2. The Resolution of the Government of Georgia No.96, May 31, 2006 on approval of the Regulation on Rule and Conditions of Issuance of Import, Export, Re-export or Transit Permit for the Specimen(s) of Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora is to be abolished.
3. The Resolution is to be put into effect as soon as is issued.

Regulation on the Rule and Conditions of Issuance of Permit to Export, Import, Re-export and Introduction from the Sea of the Specimens (their parts and derivatives) of the Species Included in the Appendices of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES)

Article 1. The aim of the regulation

1. The current regulation defines the rule and conditions of issuance of permit to export, import, re-export and introduction from the sea of the species (their parts and derivatives) included in the Appendices of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES)
2. Issues beyond this regulation are regulated directly according to the Convention.

Article 2. Management Authority issuing the permit

The Management Authority issuing the permit is the Ministry of Environment Protection of Georgia (Further – the Ministry) or Legal Entity of Public Law Revenue Service, under the Ministry of Finance of Georgia (Further – Revenue Service)

Article 3. The basis for the issuance of the permit

The permit is issued:

- a) For import, export, re-export and introduction from the sea of Appendix I specimens;
- b) For export, re-export and introduction from the sea of Appendix II specimens;
- c) For re-export of Appendix III specimens;

Article 4. Documents required to be submitted for receiving the permit

1. Written statement and all necessary documents for permit issuance might be submitted in electronic way. The submission, review and starting realization of the statement is implemented according to the article 25 of the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.

2. The written statement (aside from the requirements of the article 78 of the Administrative Code) should contain the following information:
 - a) The name (Georgian and/or Scientific), the quantity and the description of the specimens (species), intended to be exported, imported, re-exported, or introduced from the sea;
 - b) Information on the purpose of import, export, re-export and introduction from the sea of the specimens of CITES species (for commercial purposes, for zoos, for Botanical Gardens, for circuses and traveling exhibitions, for scientific purposes, for hunting trophies, for personal, for medical, for education, for re-introduction or introduction into the wild, for breeding in captivity or artificial propagation);
 - c) Information on source and time of origin of the specimens of species intended to be exported, imported, re-exported, or introduced from the sea;
 - d) Statement applying for export of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs or/and *Cyclamen coum* tubers propagated on the private plots, in addition to the information requested in this paragraph should contain following:
 - d.a) Amount of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs or/and *Cyclamen coum* tubers to be harvested annually;
 - d.b) Current estimated amount of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs or/and *Cyclamen coum* tubers on the plot;
 - d.c) Outline of plot management activities;
 - d.e) Information about the time of first planting of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs or/and *Cyclamen coum* tubers on the designated plot;
 - d.f) Information on the source first used for propagation of *Galanthus woronowii* or/and *Cyclamen coum*;
 - d.e) Information about the date and source of the last planting of *Galanthus woronowii* or/and *Cyclamen coum* tubers.

3. The statement together with the documents indicated in the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits should be accompanied with:

- a) In case of export of specimens of Appendix I species, **import permit** issued by the appropriate authority of importing country;
- b) Application to obtain export permit for the snowdrop bulbs or/and cyclamen tubers propagated on the private plots, must contain:
 - b.a) Extract from the Public Registry;
 - b.b) Positive conclusion of the LEPL National Environmental Agency. Conclusion should contain information about the total amount of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs on the plot. (In order to define the stock of *Galanthus woronowii* commercial size bulbs, ***Galanthus woronowii* stems per 0.25m² quadrat should be sampled. Stems should be sampled for 20 randomly located quadrats per site. In each quadrat stems of *Galanthus woronowii* must be counted (In case of withered stems – two leaves should be counted as one leave); after sampling of all 20 quadrats average rate for the area unit must be counted, which must be extrapolated for whole area covered by *Galanthus woronowii*. As a result density of *Galanthus woronowii* stems will be calculated. It is considered that on average one bulb has two stems and in the sampling quadrat half of the overall number of bulbs, counted according to this method, are commercial size bulbs. On the basis of this assumptions stock of commercial size bulbs should be calculated on the plots of artificial propagation.**), Quantity of commercial size bulbs, duration of propagation, Maximum quantity of the bulbs/tubers, which could be harvested from the plot annually, Date of expiry of the conclusion. At the moment of issuing of the conclusion, proportion between the amount of bulbs/tubers on the plot and amount to be exported should be relevant for enabling the maintenance of certain amount of parental stock, necessary to receive the

amount of commercial size bulbs to be exported annually. This is needed to exclude necessity of further replenishment of the bulbs. Positive conclusion might be issued for a term not exceeding three years. Fee for issuance of conclusion is defined according to the resolution of the Government of Georgia;

c) In case of import, certificate of origin issued by the exporting country, and in case of import of live specimens – documentation confirming that the proposed recipient is suitably equipped to house and care for it.

c) In case of re-export:

c.a) Permit or certificate issued by the exporting country or the country of the last re-export;

c.b) In case of re-export of live specimens of Appendix I species, import permit, issued by the country of import;

e) In case of introduction from the sea - documentation confirming that the proposed recipient is suitably equipped to house and care for specimen.

Article 5. Particular conditions for issuance of permit

1. In case of a specimen of Appendix I species:

a) Export permit is issued if the Scientific Authority advises that such export will not be detrimental to the survival of that species;

b) Import permit will be issued:

b.a) If the Scientific Authority advises that such import will not be detrimental to the survival of that species;

b.b) If the specimen will not be used for primarily commercial purposes.

c) Permit for the introduction from the sea is issued if the Scientific Authority advises that such introduction will not be detrimental to the survival of that species;

2. For specimens of Appendix II species (except export of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs and *Cyclamen coum* tubers for commercial purposes):

a) Export permit is issued if the Scientific Authority advises that such export will not be detrimental to the survival of that species;

b) The permit for introduction from the sea is issued if the Scientific Authority advises that such introduction will not be detrimental to the survival of that species.

3. The permit for export of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs and *Cyclamen coum* tubers for commercial purposes is issued:

a) On the basis of appropriate license for harvesting (which is still valid);

b) On the basis of the agreement with the person owning license for harvesting;

c) On the basis of the statement of person who owes private plot with *Galanthus* bulbs or/and *Cyclamen* tubers propagated on it.

Article 6. The rule of issuance of permit

1. The common rule of issuance of permit is regulated according to the Georgian Law on Licenses and Permits.
2. In case of necessity, The Scientific Authority defines and the Minister of Environment Protection of Georgia reviews and asserts the annual export quota for the species listed on CITES Appendices.
3. In order to implement the authorizations defined in this regulation, the Scientific Authority is designated by the decree of the Minister of Environment Protection of Georgia as an advisory body of the Minister.
4. The working rule of the Scientific Authority is defined by the decree of the Minister of Environment Protection of Georgia.

5. The Scientific Authority participates in discussions and decision making, in cases defined in this regulation, according to the so called “one window” principle.
6. Document sharing between permitting authorities and scientific authority might be made via electronic database.
7. Scientific Authority does not participate in the process of issuing permits for export of Galanthus bulbs or/and Cyclamen tubers propagated on the private plots.

Article 7. The period of validity of the permit

1. The permit has its period of validity;
2. Permits for export and re-export specimens of species are valid for six months after the date of issuance;
3. Permits for import and introduction from the sea are valid for twelve months after the date of issuance.

Article 8. The basis for refusal to issue the permit

1. The permit is not issued by the issuing Authority, if:
 - a) The statement and attached documents do not satisfy the requirements of the law and they are not refined by the person seeking for the permit within the terms defined by the Management Authority;
 - b) The person seeking for the permit does not satisfy the established terms for receiving the permit.
 - c) The person seeking for the permit is not eligible to work in permissible field by the verdict being in act (or by the decision of the court).
2. Export permit for snowdrop bulbs or/and Cyclamen tubers propagated on the private plots is not issued if:
 - a) Snowdrop or/and Cyclamen is not propagated more five years before than the request to obtain the permit is submitted.
- b) In case of harvesting of full amount of commercial size bulbs/tubers at least 3 years have not been passed yet.
 - c) Are not submitted following documents:
 - c.a) Positive conclusion of the LEPL National Environment Agency;
 - c.b) Special document confirming registration of the plot in the special registry. Content of this document is defined by the resolution of the LEPL National Environmental Agency;
 - c.c) Extract from the Public Registry.

Article 9. The rights and obligations of the organization issuing permits:

The rights and obligations of the organization issuing permits are defined within the Georgian Law on Licenses and Permits.

Article 9¹. Obligations of the permit owner

Owner of the permit for export of Galanthus woronowii bulbs or/and Cyclamen coum tubers is obliged to:

- a) Harvest Galanthus woronowii bulbs or/and Cyclamen coum tubets only from the plots indicated in the permit;

- b) After receiving of the permit and harvesting of *Galanthus woronowii* bulbs or/and *Cyclamen coum* tubers, permit owner is obliged to present conclusion of the LEPL National Environmental Agency, confirming the fact of harvesting from designated plot.

Article 10. The permit form

1. Permit is issued in 4 copies. 1 copy remains in the issuing authority, Original and two copies are given to the applicant to present to the customs service of Georgia, where during the export/re-export customs officer endorses permits with signature and personal stamp. Endorsed original and copy is presented to the customs service of importing country.
2. The imprint of the seal of the Ministry together with the names and specimens of signatures of the persons empowered to sign the permit are sent to the Secretariat of the Convention.

Article 11. Loss or damage of the permit

In case of loss or damage of the permit by the owner norms set out in the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits are used.

Article 12. Abolition of the Permit and changes in the permit

1. Rules for abolition of the permit or changes in it are defined by the Law of Georgia on Licensing and Permitting.
2. Abolition of the permit or changes in it should be notified in a written form to the owner of the permit, to the Secretariat of the Convention and to the appropriate Party (member state).

Article 13. Permitting fee

The amount of the permitting fee as well as rule of payment of it to the budget is defined by the Law of Georgia on Licensing and Permitting Fees.

Article 14. Controlling the implementation of the permitting terms

Controlling the implementation of the permitting terms, as well as responsibility for violation of them is defined by the Law of Georgia on Licenses and Permits.
